- English grammar and style should be carefully revised.

- At the end of the Introduction add a paragraph on how the rest of the paper is organized and developed, typically a summary on the rest.

- At the bed pinning of the paper, before the Introduction section, a Nomenclature section, not numbered, should be added with a list, in alphabetic order, of all the used distinct symbols/acronyms and their meaning. should be added with a list, in alphabetic order, of all the used distinct symbols during the meaning.

References are partially outdated, more recent literature review from journals' papers published after 2020 should be suitable. - The review section should be more expanded based on the proposed references list.

- The conclusion is week. In the Conclusions, the authors should state the scope and the aims of this investigation, along with important research directions on this issue.

- In the Conclusion paragraph the Authors could propose further improvements to be set for their proposal for a future development.

- Letters (a), (b), ... with relative description for the subfigures in Figs. 2, 10 should be outside the figures, in text format.
